Sancerre Rose Les Hospices 2011

Extremely well structured strawberry, apricot and gooseberry fruit flavours.
Completely elegant. £9.80/ 58.80

Sancerre Rose Le Grand Fricambault Domaine Andre Neveu 2010

Wonderfully light and fruity, this delicious Sancerre rose is made from Pinot Noir grapes providing delicious aromas of fresh strawberries. Crisp and dry on the finish with classic Loire Valley minerality. £11.35/ 68.10

Chateau d'Astros Rose 2010

This salmon-hued rose is well-balanced and has an intense nose of grapefruit and other exotic fruits. £6.45/44.70

Whispering Angel Rose 2010

Pale salmon in colour, this is delicate and fresh with plenty of crisp strawberry fruit and a long finish. £12.95/77.70

Chateau d'Esclans Garrus Rose 2008

From 8-year-old Grenache vines. Seems the palest and most orange of the 28s. Slightly more savoury and more obviously garrigue-influenced than Les Clans. Lovely creamy texture and a little bit of lemon cream on the finish. "Reminds me of a white burgundy in some ways.

Delicato Zinfandel Rose 2010

Drier than many Zinfandel rosés, this nevertheless has plenty of raspberry, strawberry and watermelon fruit flavours. Juicy and light, it has a refreshing bright acidity on the finish. £6.30/43.80
