France, Burgundy

Domaine Des Marrionniers – *Formed in 1976 the amalgamation of 4 small quality producers in prime Chablis country. Consistently producing quality wines.*

Chablis 2009

Elegant with strong minerality. Good value classic Chablis. £10.20/61.20

Chablis 1er Cru Montmains 2009

Beautifully refined, golden green and crystal clear. Citrus, flint with a thirst quenching lemon zing, classic and refined. £15.90/95.40

Chablis Domaine Herve Azo 2009

This wine, like Azo's Petit Chablis is an overachiever. Normally held back at the winery for an extra year, it shows the captivating yeasty quality in the nose that true Chablis should have. It is both fleshy and full while retaining a solid mineral core and zesty acidity. Wines from this famous region are some of the most versatile with food, and this is no exception. Very thirst quenching, it will marry well with all seafood and poultry as well as with stronger cheese such as Gruyère or Comté. £11.40/68.40

Beune Pouilly Fuisse 2009

100% Chardonnay, 10 mths in oak. Elegant and restrained, slightly floral with hints of hazelnuts and toasted almonds. A rich, luscious wine. Enjoy with shellfish, white meats etc. £12.46/74.89

Domaine Simonin, Macon Vergisson 2009

Elegant and light Chardonnay. Dry with a nice balance of fruit and oak. Very drinkable! £9.99/ 59.94

Domaine Roux Pere et Fils – *Based in the village of St Aubin, the Roux family own 70ha of vineyards which the current generation of brothers have propelled to the top of the list of burgundy producers.*

Puligny-Montrachet Les Enseignerres 2008

Elegant oak aged Chardonnay, ripe apple, lemon and tropical fruits, beautifully balanced and well rounded. A true classic. £28.72/172.33

Sancerre Les Hospices Paul Buisse 2010

Classic Sauvignon Blanc, pure and fruity, refined, fresh and flinty. Great with fish and seafood, or just glug! £9.95/59.70

Vouvray Clos Berger 2010

Floral notes of acacia with aromas of fresh almonds and a round, fresh palate. Great to drink on it's own, and is well suited to light fish dishes. £7.15/42.90

Pouilly Fume Les Les Berthiers 2009/2010

Dry, crisp Sav Blanc, green apples and lime, flint and minerals. £11.40/68.40

Made with 60% Albillo and 40% Macabeo grapes, this rare wine is very popular within the Madrid wine bar scene. Powerful and complex on the palate with peachy fruit and superb minerality. £11.50/69.00

Vinho Verde Conde Villar Quinta das Arcas 2011

Light and delicious, this unusual wine as aromas of pineapple, mango and citrus fruits. Well balanced with a good finish. £6.25/37.50

Conde Villar Alvarinho Quinta das Arcas 2011

California, Napa Valley

Napa Valley Chardonnay 2010

Domaine Baron Rothschild Rothschild-Lafite *Chilean outpost of the Lafite dynasty producing consistently high quality wines.*

Los Vascos Chardonnay, 2009

Fresh delicate and fruity with aromas of melon and grapefruit. Great quality Chardonnay from South America. £10.99/65.94

Los Vascos Sauvignon Blanc, 2009

Normally we wouldn't include so many wines from the same producer – we couldn't resist this. Remarkable, aromatic and crisp. £10.99/65.94

Argentina

Argento – Leading vineyard in Argentina

Chardonnay/ Viognier 2011

Aromas of ripe tropical fruits, with notes of peach and pineapple. £5.95/35.70

Pinot Grigio 2011

Delicate floral aromas and tropical fruits on the nose with ripe pineapple and peach flavours and a bright crisp finish. £5.95/35.70

The Money Spider Roussanne 2009

100% Roussane grapes, floral and expressive, smooth and fresh. £9.75/58.50

The Hermit Crab Viognier Marsanne 2010

This wine has nectarine, peach and apricot aromas. The Viognier grape adds lots of flavour and body to the wine, whilst the Marsanne adds a nuttiness and freshness. £8.65/51.90

The Stump Jump Reisling/Sav Blanc/Marsanne 2010

A refreshing wine with crisp citrus, peach and nectarine flavours alongside honeysuckle and a hint of melon. £7.15/42.90

Murray Darling

Spee'wah Estate- *The Spee'Wah range is inspired by Crooked Mick – one of Australia's most popular mythical heroes. Elizabeth Richardson is the winemaker behind the label and she has a trophy cabinet stuffed full of medals from her stint at Capel Vale in WA. Liz has one aim and one aim only: to ensure you reach for a second and third glass. Her knowledge of the Murray Darling vineyards is second to none and her contact book of growers is the envy of her peers. She has cherry picked parcels of outstanding fruit to make these wines and the quality shines through as soon as the bottles are opened.*

The Spee'wah Semillon Sauvignon Blanc

A refreshing wine with notes of cut grass and a green apple bite. £6.25/37.50

The Spee'wah Houseboat Chardonnay 2011

This wine has a great fruit character with wonderfully integrated oak allowing for a soft, creamy finish. £6.25/37.50

Hunter Valley

Glenguin Estate- Fairytale story of the Scottish Baron, Robin Tedder MW, exile from the House of Lords travelling to Australia and creating some of the finest handcrafted wines in Australia. The Glenguin estate was planted 19yrs ago by the Tedder family and Robin Tedder has become one of Australians' 15 Masters of Wine. They have set out to produce small quantities of exciting balanced wines from hand tended vines and in the process have created some of the most desirable wines from Australia today. Old Broke Block Semillon 2006/7

Protos Chardonnay 2007/9

Journey's End

The stunning vineyards on the Journeys End Estate were purchased and replanted by the Gabb family in 1996. This beautiful location in the Helderberg Basin near Sir Lowry's Pass benefits from South facing slopes and cool coastal

The Schaapenberg Terroir with its sea facing slopes has started to draw comparison with some of Bordeaux's best with some exceptional wines emerging from the area. 2010 saw the completion of a brand new state of the art boutique winery set in the heart of the vineyards. The consistently strong run of top wine awards achieved by Journey's End are testament to its status as one of South Africa's most premium wine Estates.

Haystack Chardonnay 2010

Well focused flavours showing citrus and tropical fruits and mineral tones with a long and elegant finish and excellent fruit/ oak integration. £7.60/ 45.60

Weather Station Sauvignon Blanc 2011

A bright and fresh wine with tropical notes of lemon and grapefruit leading on to a clean mineral finish. £8.25/49.50

Robertson

Springfield Estate

Brother and sister team Abrie and Jeanette Bruwer are the complete opposite of your typical university trained have-cultured-yeast-will-travel flying winemakers. Springfield Estate choose to take the path less travelled and go against the grain in order to make sure the drinking experience is perfect at the consumer end and sustainable at their end. Their wines are all about their rocky, unforgiving terroir in Robertson, and stand head and shoulders above most producers for sheer quality.

Life From Stone Sauvignon Blanc 2010

A delicious dry and fresh Sauvignon with lime, gooseberry and passion fruit notes. £8.30/49.80

Method Ancienne Chardonnay 2006

This wine is called "Methode Ancienne" because it is made in an old-fashioned style, much like the way traditional French winemakers make their wine. The end result is a toasty, full-bodied wine with tropical fruit flavours and a hint of creaminess. £15.60/93.60

Graham Beck

Graham Beck is a giant of the South African wine scene and has led the country's thundering success since the end of Apartheid in 1994. Graham Beck is perhaps best known as a producer of some of the New World's finest sparkling wines.

Apart from the sparkling wines, Beck also produces a range of excellent reds and whites many with a string of awards to their name.

The Game Reserve Chenin Blanc

Easy drinking, pleasant wine. Tropical fruit, ripe pineapple and melon. Clean, crisp aftertaste. £7.40/£44.40

Viognier 2009

A fruity nose with luscious peach and citrus characters, full bodied and full of character! £7.15/42.90
